- NO** Paint Cans or Aerosol Cans
- NO** Motor Oil Bottles
- NO** Appliances
- NO** Hangers, Fencing or Scrap Metal
- NO** Waxed Containers (Orange juice boxes, etc.)
- NO** 6, 12, 24 Pack Pop/Beer Boxes
- NO** Containers with Food Residue
