The board will discuss the gravel agreement with the ICRC at the April or May board meetings.

The Township board prepared the 2024-2025 budget. The approval of this budget will be held March 26, 2024 at the annual meeting.

Trustee Simon motion to pay the bills presented by Clerk Keilen seconded by Treasurer Schneider and carried.

Trustee Simon motioned to approve 10 acres of land be reserved for the New Portland Township Hall and property reserved for Portland Township located within the 31 acres along Grand River Ave./Knox rd. seconded by Clerk Keilen. 3-yes, 2-no, motion carried.

Supervisor Jensen motioned to rent the Barnes Rd. property for farming this year at the same rate as 2023 with a signed agreement based on a contingency of selling the property seconded by Trustee VanLente. 4-yes, 1-no, motion carried.

There will be 26 acres along the Grand River/Knox rd. property to be bid out to rent for farming this year. Supervisor Jensen will process the bids.

Trustee Simon motioned to approve up to \$1,000 to survey the 10 acres of property reserved for the new township hall and reserved property seconded by Trustee VanLente and carried.

Supervisor Jensen motioned to adjourn at 8:48pm seconded by Trustee Simon and carried.
