

PUBLIC NOTICE

Portland Township in Ionia County Applications for Deferment of Summer 2026 Taxes

Portland township treasurer in Ionia County is currently accepting applications for summer 2026 tax deferments (deferments are not exemptions). To qualify, a household annual income cannot exceed \$40,000. The applicants(s) must also be

1. 62 years of age or older, including the unmarried surviving spouse of a person who was 62 years or older at the time of death
2. Paraplegic, Hemiplegic, or Quadriplegic
3. Eligible Service person, Eligible Veteran, Eligible Widow or Widower
4. Blind Person
5. Totally and Permanently Disabled

Those that farm agricultural real property may also qualify if the gross receipts of agricultural or horticultural operations in the previous year (or the average gross receipts for such operations in the previous three years) are not less than the household income for the preceding calendar year or the combined household incomes in the previous year of the individual members of a limited liability company that owns the agricultural real property.

Deferments can only be filed and dated from 7-1-26 thru 9-14-26. Deferments must be filed annually. Postmarks will not be accepted. Defers the due date of the SUMMER taxes without penalty or interest charges until February 15. (Must be received by February 14).
